## 1. Overview & Objectives

- To protect and improve private drinking water
- Explore a funding program along the lines of the Huron Model
- GSWA would partner with Conservation Sudbury (CS)
  - GSWA would seek funding, administer funds and report to grantor
  - CS would run and administer the program
- Develop a Pilot Stewardship Program modeled after the Ontario Drinking Water Stewardship Program
  - Grants to fund septic system repair or replacement
  - Volunteer participation carrot would be grant dollars
  - Grant 50 to 80% of cost cap of \$5,000 to \$7,000
  - Open to homeowners within City of Greater Sudbury
  - Septic systems within 200m of a water body
- Funding could start small at \$100,000
- Potential funding partners
  - City of Sudbury
  - Ontario Trillium Foundation
  - GSWA would seek charitable status to open up funding opportunities

## 2. Roundtable Discussion

- How much additional work would Stewardship Program mean for SDHU
- Dependent on types and range of issues to be addressed
- Must define focus and scope
  - Do we want to include small repairs, pump-outs and malfunctions
  - Too many applications would make program unmanageable
- Could focus on septic systems leaching effluent into environment
  - Would narrow scope and be more manageable
  - Would require a site visit to verify necessity of contractor recommendation
  - Once SDHU confirms a leaking septic system they have authority to ensure homeowner replaces or repairs it a permit is required
  - Permit costs \$750
  - Permit would cover cost of site visits
- Consider a ceiling on maximum grant payout per project
  - Allows for better planning based on available funds
- Question of how many septic systems would require replacement

## 3. Next Steps

- SDHU requested a formal proposal for consideration
  Linda will arrange a meeting with CS and our PDWPC to define our focus and prepare a formal proposal
