  - A shoreline evaluation and stewardship program
  - Implements science-based stewardship
  - A great education and motivational tool
  - Engages the community for lasting benefits
  - Helps make lakes healthier for people and wildlife
  - Conducted by the City of Sudbury for 2 or 3 years Lana Haslam is the contact
  - Area lakes volunteered to take part in the program
  - City took photos of homes on the lake, and provide a nice booklet to the property owner to inform of ways to lessen their impact on the lake
  - A program that fits with GSWA mission, and benefits broadly
- Action: Linda will contact Lana to find out how successful the Love Your Lakes program is/was, and how we could support or start such a program.
- Septic Socials or Doc Talk have been a success in other areas
  - Host community gatherings to educate about septic systems
  - Guest speakers
    - Types, care and maintenance of septic systems
    - Troubleshooting
    - Impacts or connection between properly working septic systems and healthy aquifers, creeks, rivers and lakes
