EURASIAN WATERMILFOIL



Protect
Our Living
Lakes

Small
reddish flowers
above water
(mid-summer)

Stems branch near
water surface

Long, stringy stems
often reddish



3-5 feathery leaves arranged
in whorls (circles) on stems.
Twelve (12) or more leaflet
pairs on each

In Greater Sudbury, 18 lakes are affected with Eurasian watermilfoil.

INSPECT

- Inspect boat, trailer and equipment
- Remove aquatic plants and animals
- Put them in the garbage

CLEAN

- Rinse your boat with hot water OR
- Spray with a pressure washer OR
- Let it dry in the sun for 5 days

DRAIN

- Drain your bilge
- Drain your live well
- Drain your engine & anchor box
